(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER MARCH 2022

To allow works to be carried out on iron work, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of The Street, Ryarsh.

A closure is planned from 10th March 2022, between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30, with estimated completion by 11th March 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE70711303897-01 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network

The Street will be closed between the junctions with Chapel Street and Roughetts Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while ironwork works are undertaken by Kent County Council.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Roughetts Road, A20 London Road, A228 Ashton Way, Leybourne By Pass, Birling Road, Bull Road, Ryarsh Road and vice versa.
