(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER JUNE 2022

To allow cabling works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of The Street, Ryarsh.

A closure is planned from 22nd June 2022, with estimated completion by 24th June 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (UY001-ADD-18652-01 - Trooli). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network

The Street will be closed from outside Stoned Lodge to outside number 2 Carrill's Cottages, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while cabling works are undertaken by Trooli.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Birling Road, Ryarsh Road, Bull Road, Leybourne By Pass, A228 Ashton Way, A20 London Road, Trottiscliffe Road, Woodgate Road, The Street and vice versa.
