The Street, Ryarsh

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER AUGUST 2023

To allow plant works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of The Street, Ryarsh.

A closure is planned from 1st August 2023, for up to one day, between the hours of 08.00 and 18.00, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC11700000000260956DNO1-01 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network

The Street will be closed between Old School Lane and Workhouse Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while plant works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via The Street, Roughetts Road, A20 London Road, A228 Ashton Way, A228 Leybourne Bypass, Birling Road, Ryarsh Road, Birling Road, The Street and vice versa.
