Buses 58 and 70 from 13 February 2023

Kent County Council financial support for buses 58 and 70 ends from 12 February 2023 and school-time buses 558/578 also cease to serve the Malling area. However, until July 2023, Nu-Venture will continue to operate a limited replacement dayitme service on certain days of the week as shown below.
