A228 CASTLE WAY, LEYBOURNE

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that A228 Castle Way, Leybourne will be closed to through traffic, on or after 10th June 2024 for up to 2 nights.

The road will be closed at the junctions of Leybourne Way and Leybourne Lakes (Ham Hill) roundabout (Medway/Northbound only).

The alternative route is via A228 Castle Way, Join M20 J4, Exit M20 J6, A229 Bluebell Hill, Join M2 J3, Exit M2 J2, A228 Sundridge Hill, A228 Rochester Road, A228 Holborough Road, A228 Snodland Bypass and vice versa.

For non motorway traffic please follow Leybourne Way, New Hythe Lane, A20 London Road, Station Road, Forstal Road, Rochester Road, Pilgrims Way, New Court Road, Peters Bridge Road, A228 Snodland Bypass and vice versa.

It is planned that the road will be closed between 21:00 hrs and 05:00 hrs each night.

This closure is necessary to enable carriageway resurfacing to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
